

SIGN THE RECALL - CHAIR ANN WHEELER PWC BOARD OF COUNTY SUPERVISORS

These are the FACTS. This recall is about HOLDING ELECTED OFFICIALS ACCOUNTABLE TO LAW AND ETHICAL STANDARDS, regardless of political party. This is a bi-partisan effort. We deserve fair and unbiased representation.

RECALL ALLEGATIONS AT A GLANCE:

- Ann Wheeler significantly increased her stock portfolio after she was elected. She invested heavily in data center and data center affiliated companies.
- During the same period, Wheeler pushed to approve multiple rezonings of agricultural and residential land for data centers despite public outcry and staff/planning commission statements of concern/opposition.
- The public became aware that Wheeler held up to a quarter MILLION dollars worth of stock in a company trying to redevelop 800 acres of agricultural land along Pageland Lane for data centers — one of the biggest land deals in NOVA — a highly unpopular project due to massive environmental/financial impacts, and proximity to Manassas Nat'l Battlefield.
- After this information went public and under media pressure, Wheeler sold the stock and issued a public comment saying she did not and would not seek a legal opinion from the commonwealth or county attorney.
- She failed to disclose her relevant holdings prior to Board votes and discussions, in violation of Virginia code.
- The data center company she invested in pays quarterly dividends; if she profited more than \$5000 in dividends, per Virginia state code, she is prohibited from voting, discussing, or participating in any meetings surrounding that topic.
- Her actions constitute neglect of duty and misuse of office. Wheeler has put her personal financial interests above those of the residents of the county.
- A recall will stop personal profiteering on the backs of citizens and stop bad proposals from moving forward.
- A recall petition is necessary to place the matter before a Prince William County Circuit Court judge. If the judge rules favorably, a special citizen election is held for a replacement.
