Electric Transmission Needs in Prince William County

Dear Neighbor:

At Dominion Energy, we are dedicated to maintaining reliable and secure electric service in the communities we serve. We are writing to let you know about a new electric transmission project in your area of Prince William County, Virginia.

Prince William County continues to diversify its economic prospects with the data center industry across the county. As data center development continues to grow, there is a need for new electric infrastructure. As such, we are currently evaluating and planning for a new project in the Innovation Park area of the county. This project, called the Hornbaker 230 kV Line and Hornbaker Switching Station Project, proposes to construct approximately 1.5 miles of new double-circuit 230 kV transmission line, with an estimated 100 foot right of way, via a tie-in point from existing transmission facilities in the area. This new line would connect to a new switching station located off Hornbaker Road.

We are currently in the conceptual phase and are seeking input prior to submitting an application with the Virginia State Corporation Commission (SCC). Doing so allows us to hear any concerns you may have as we work to meet the project's needs. Toward that end, we would like to invite you to participate in an upcoming community meeting to discuss the project. Meeting details are as follows:
